FIREARMS

Clients are advised to bring their own firearms, although these can be provided at a nominal fee (rifles of various caliber are available). Firearms brought into the country must be declared at the point of entry where a temporary permit will be issued for the duration of your stay.

The choice of firearm is largely up to the individual client, however we do recommend a .270 rifle or bigger for most plains game such as Blesbok or Impala. For larger animals like Eland and Zebra, we recommend a .300 calibre as a minimum. For big game hunting we suggest you liaise with our professional hunter prior to your departure to Al Thandiwe. We advise you to bring as much ammunition as you can, in addition to rifle cleaning equipment and sturdy gun cases.

CLOTHING

Daytime temperatures are mild and dry in winter (May to September) with little chance of rain as Al Thandiwe is in a summer rainfall area. The evenings however, can get very cold. We recommend light khaki clothing including a light windbreaker for day time, and warm clothes including a thick warm jacket for the evenings. Make certain that you bring comfortable well worn-in walking shoes and a hat or cap for protection from the sun. Other items of importance are sunglasses, binoculars, a knife, reliable camera and plenty of film.
